Median household income is **\$1.6K above** the national median household income of \$57.7K.

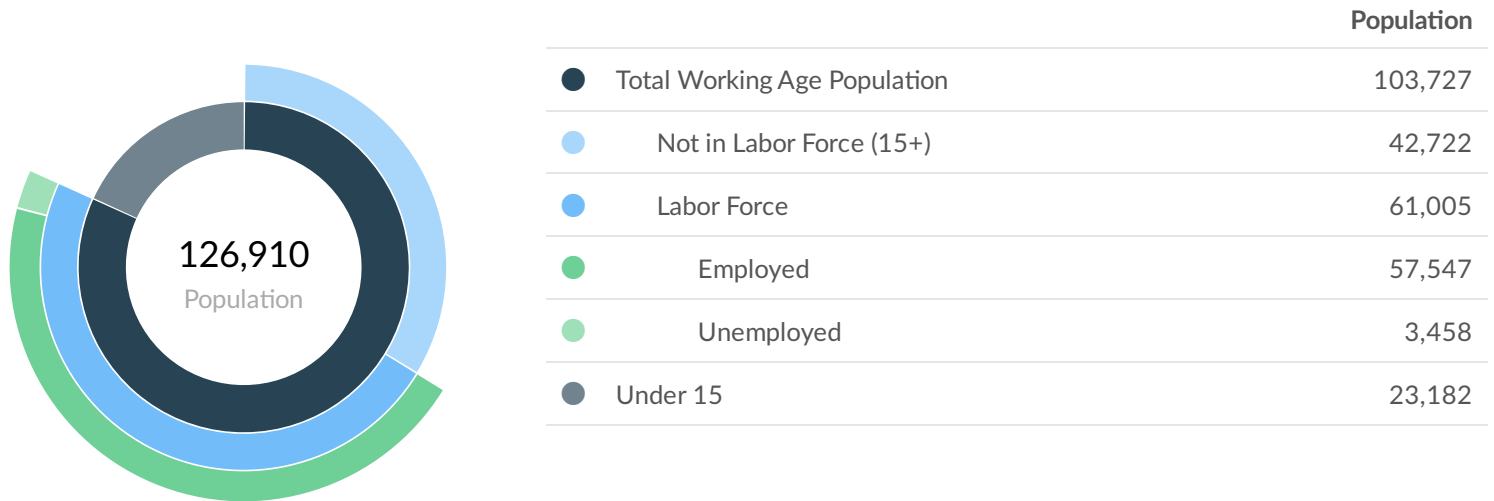
Takeaways

- From 2013 to 2018, jobs **increased by 8.7%** in Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA from 53,166 to **57,796**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 8.2% by 0.5%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 59.6% to 58.8% between 2013 and 2018**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.0% of Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.7% below the national average), and **10.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

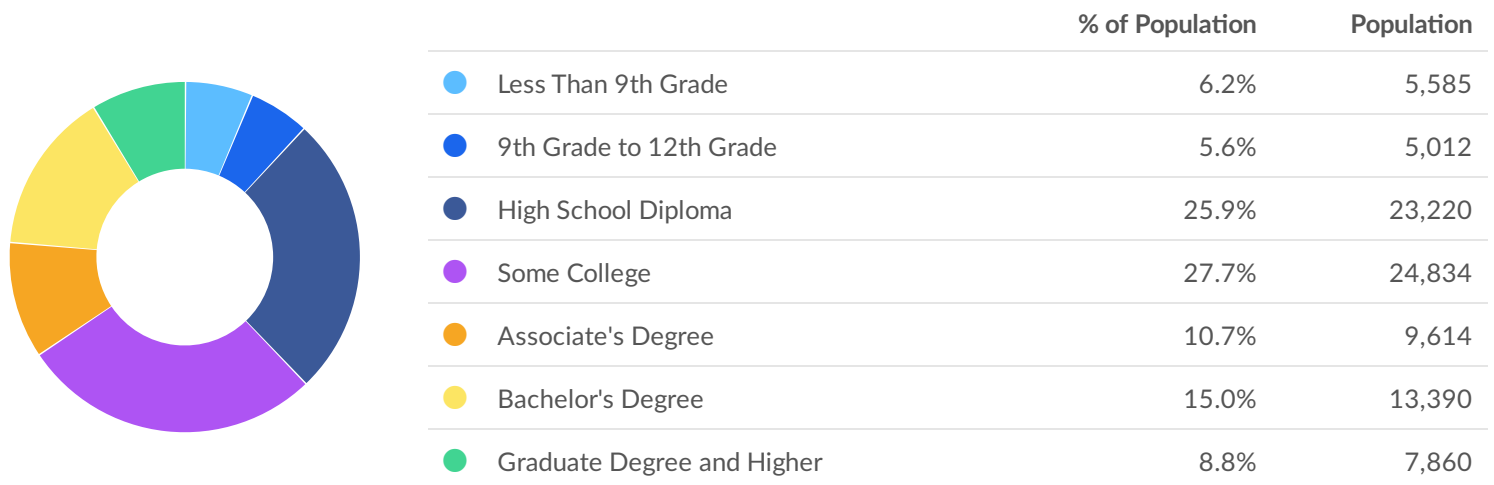

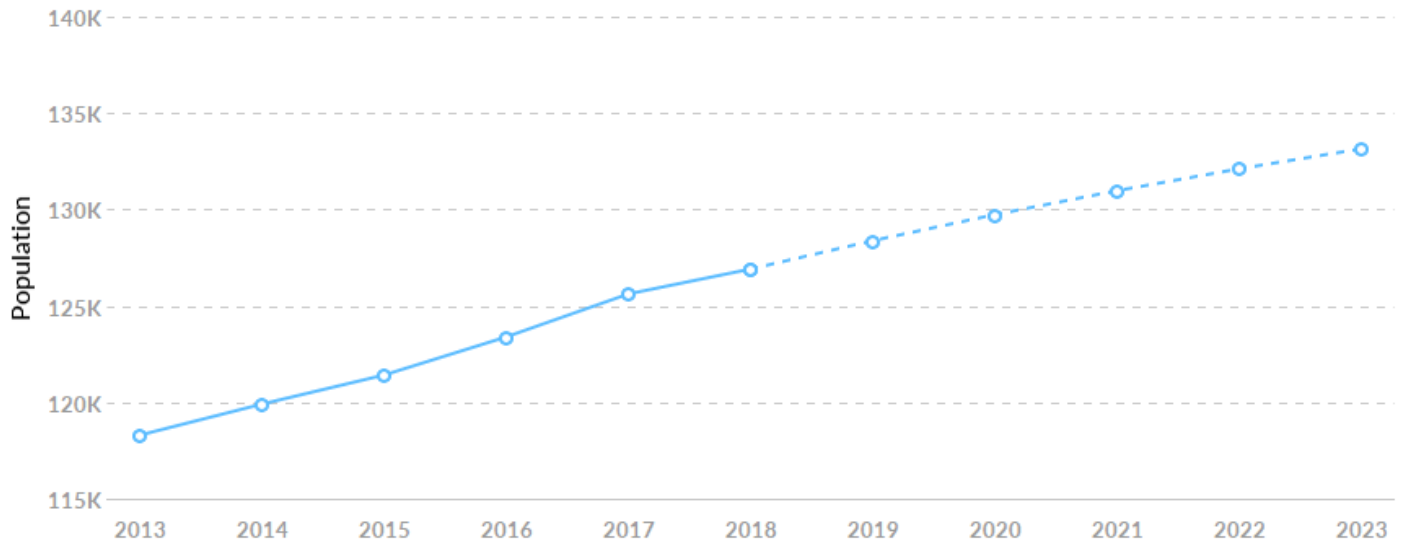

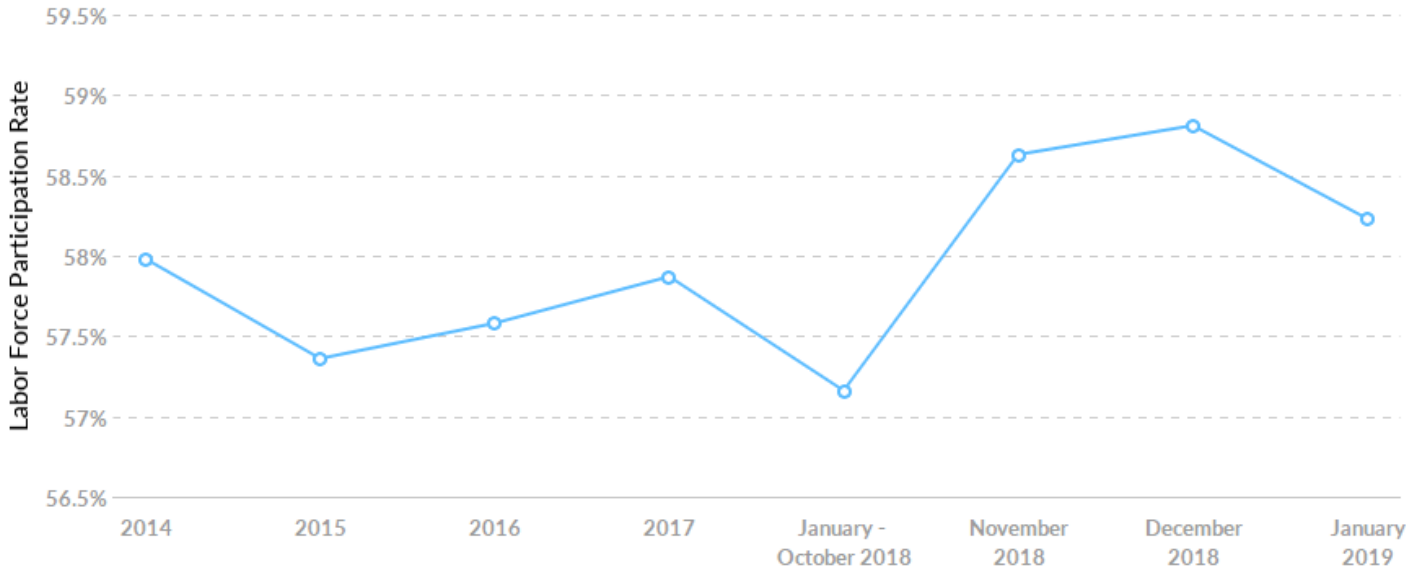

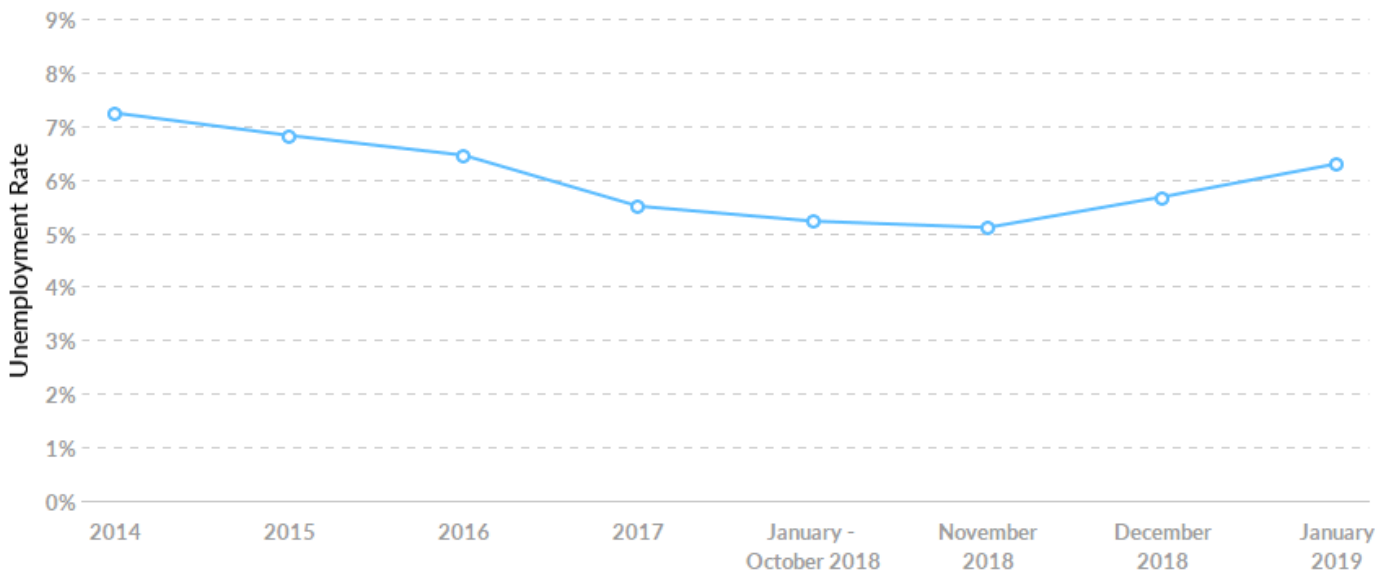

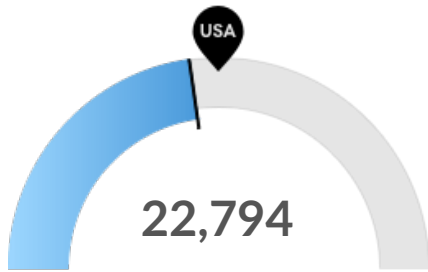
Unemployment Rate Trends

Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 6.29%, **decreasing from 7.24%** 5 years before.



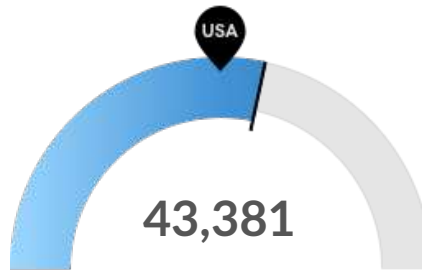

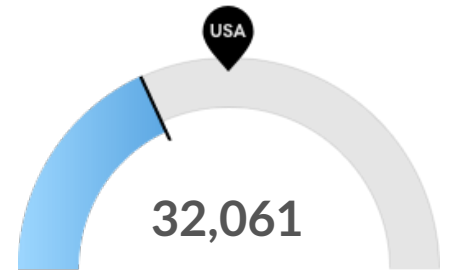
Millennials

Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA has 22,794 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 26,018.



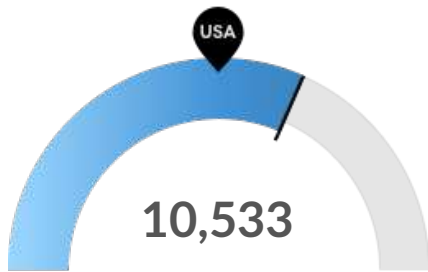
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA. The national average for an area this size is 35,811 people 55 or older, while there are 43,381 here.



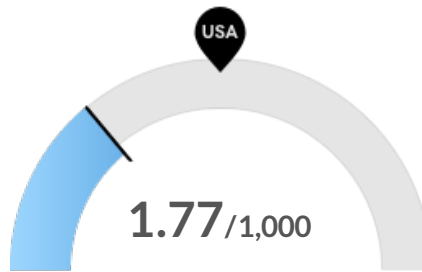
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA. The national average for an area this size is 49,333 racially diverse people, while there are 32,061 here.



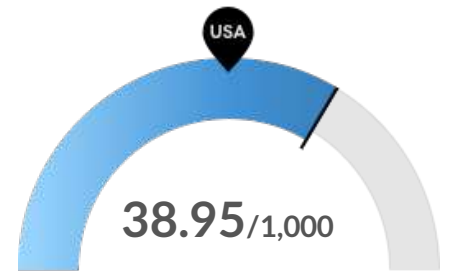
Veterans

Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA has 1.77 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.



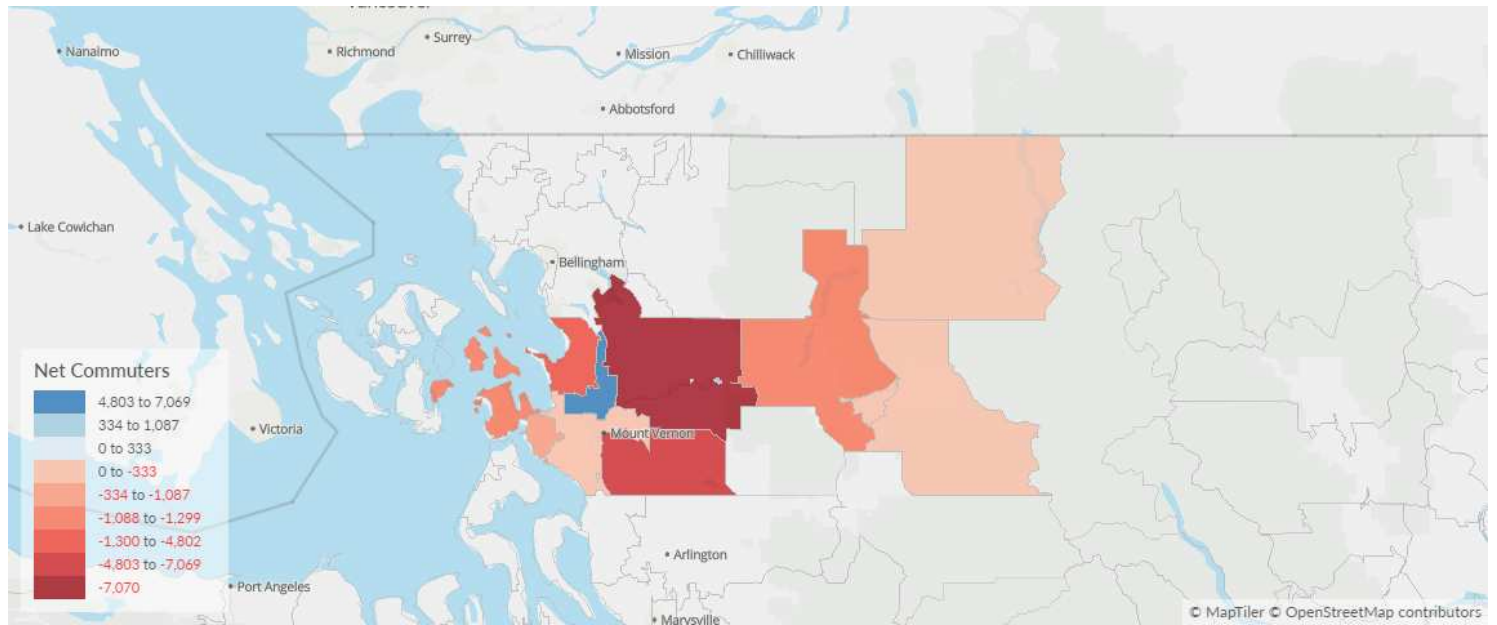
Property Crime

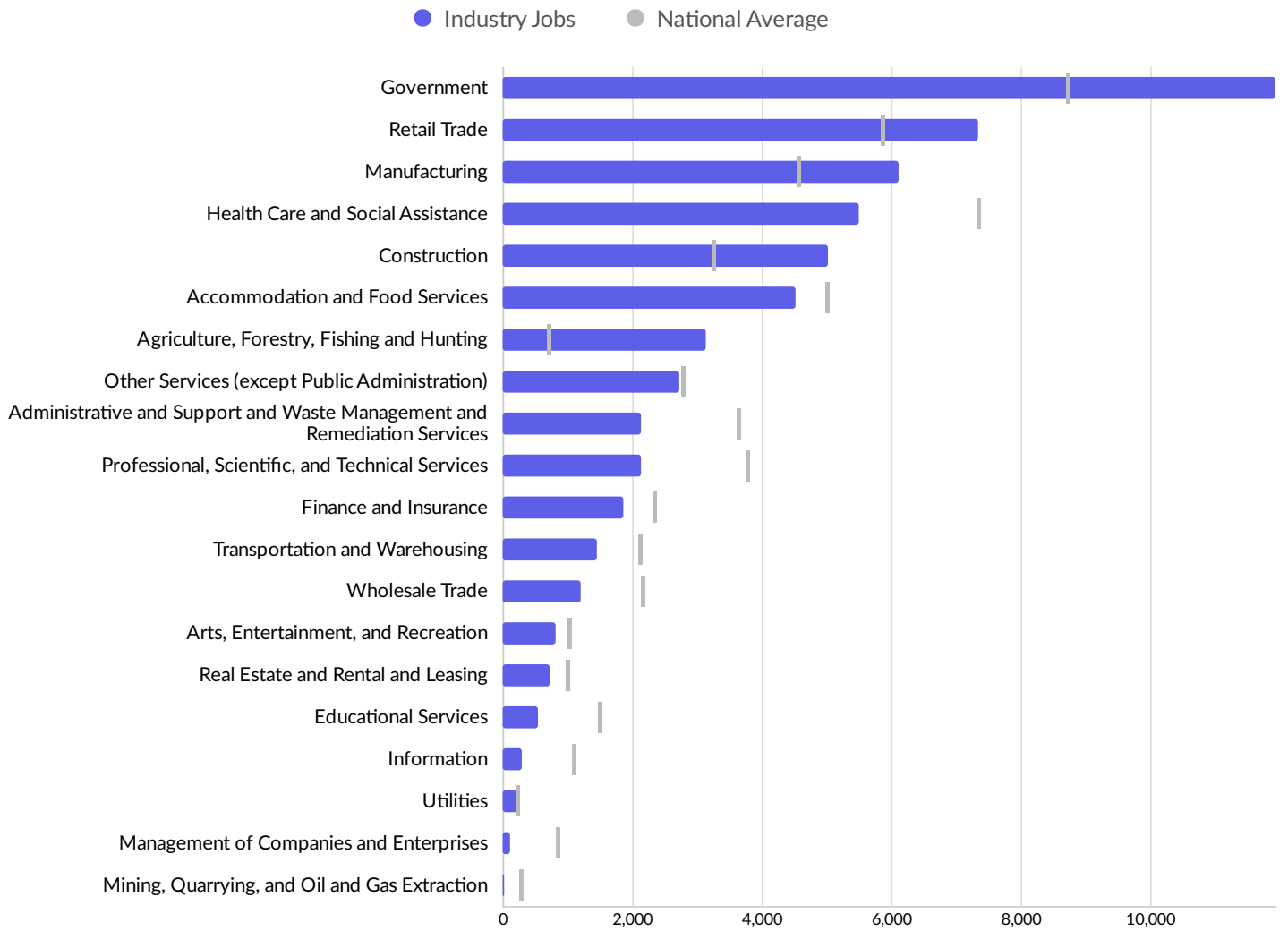

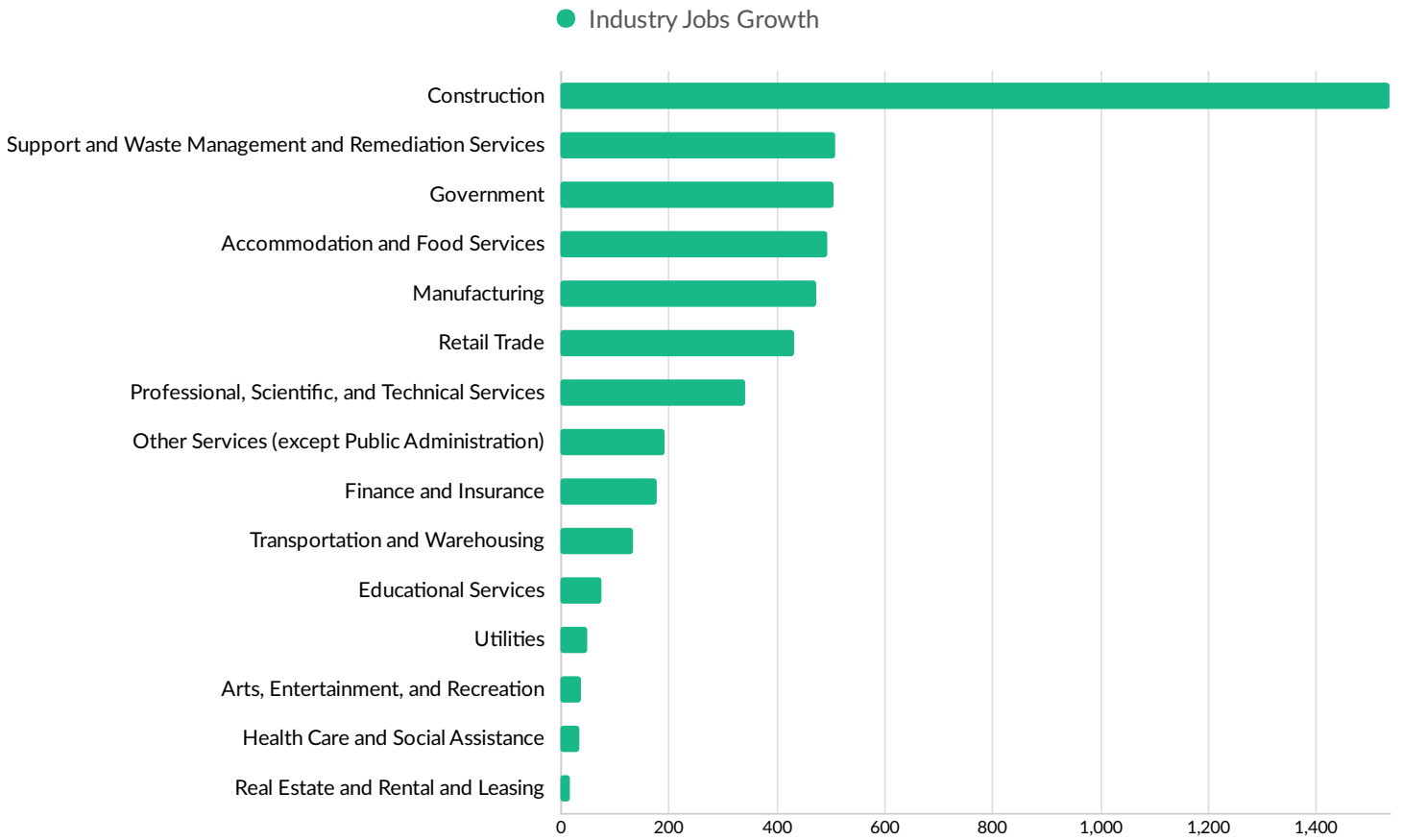

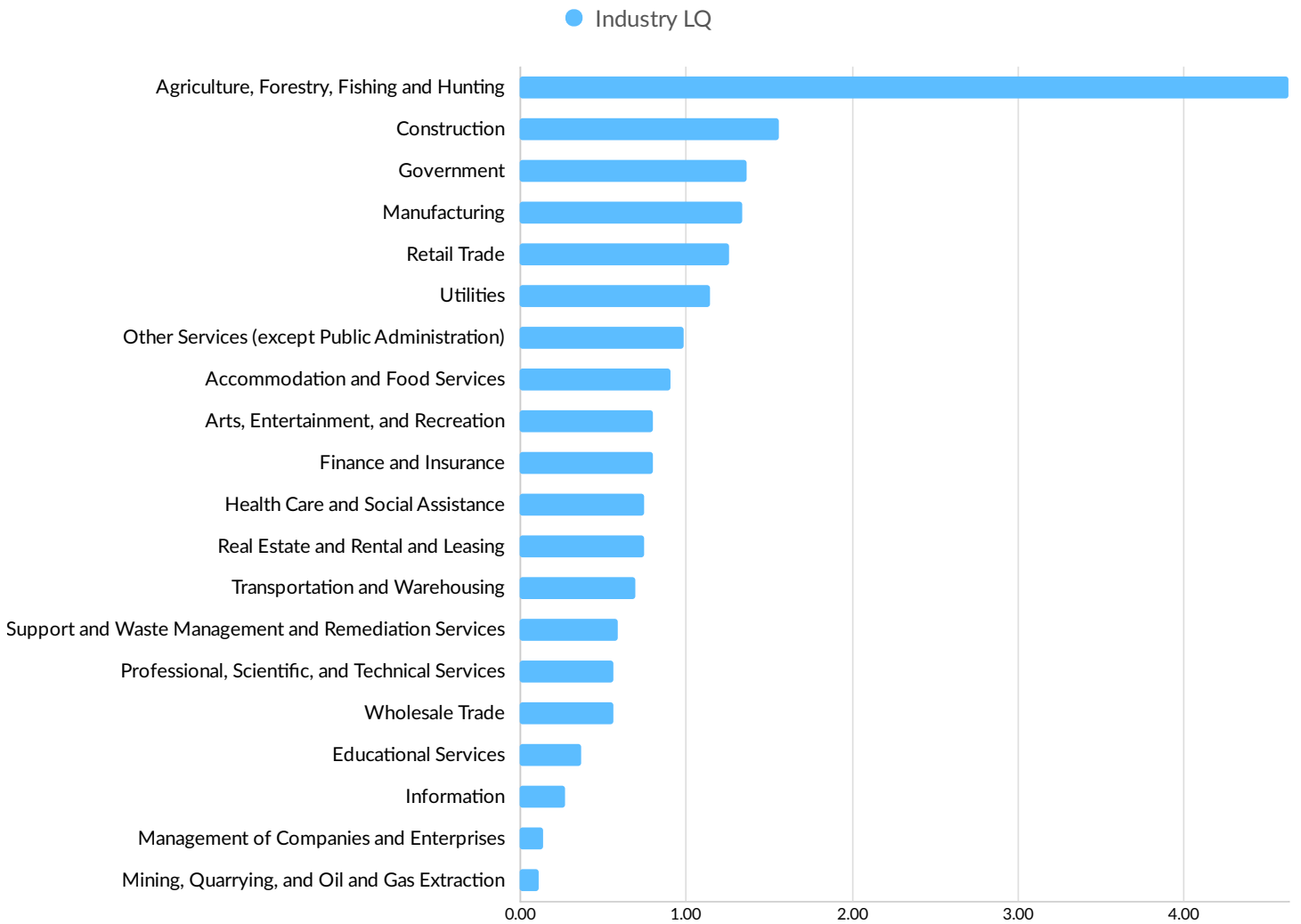

Top Growing Industries



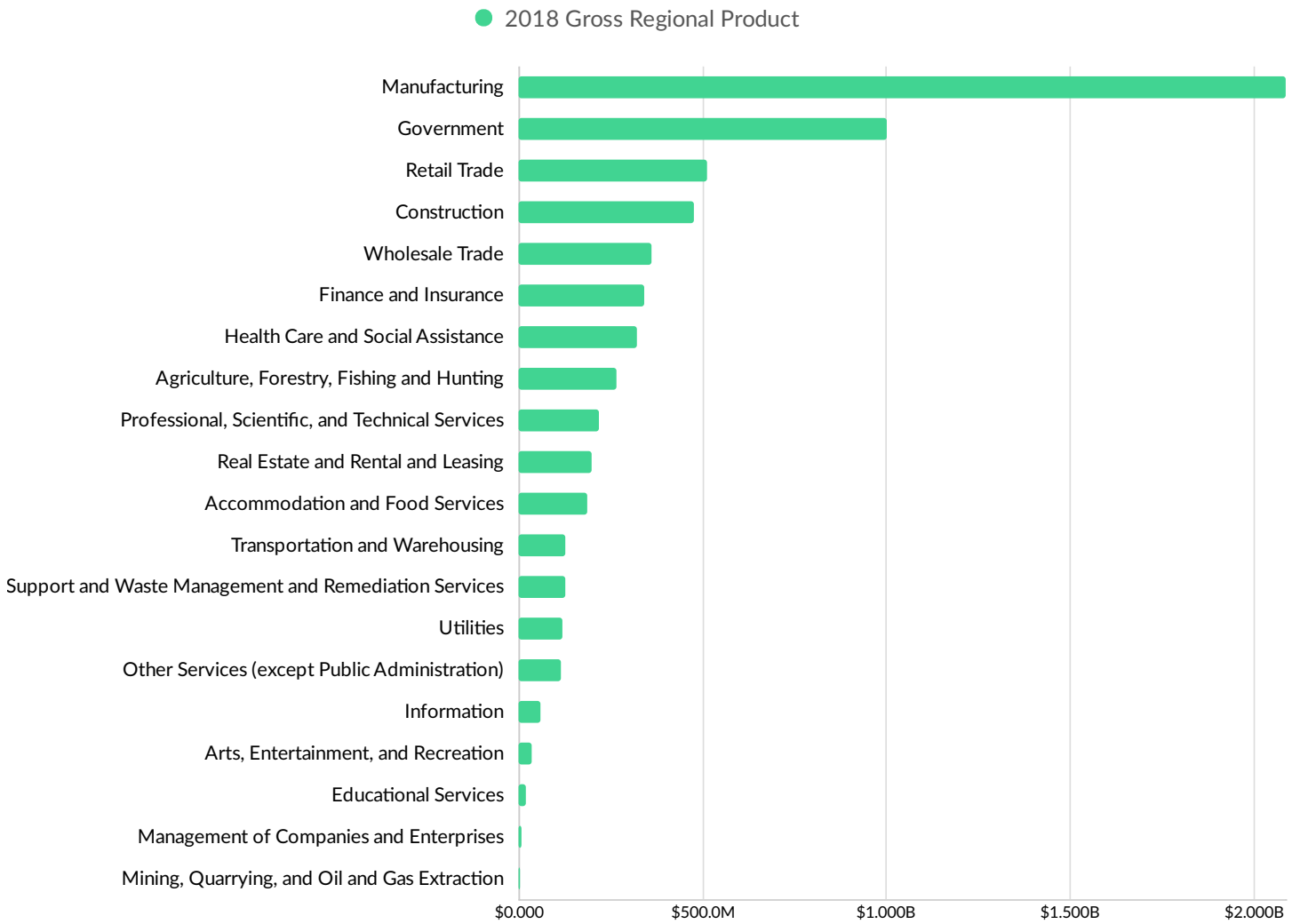

Top Industry LQ



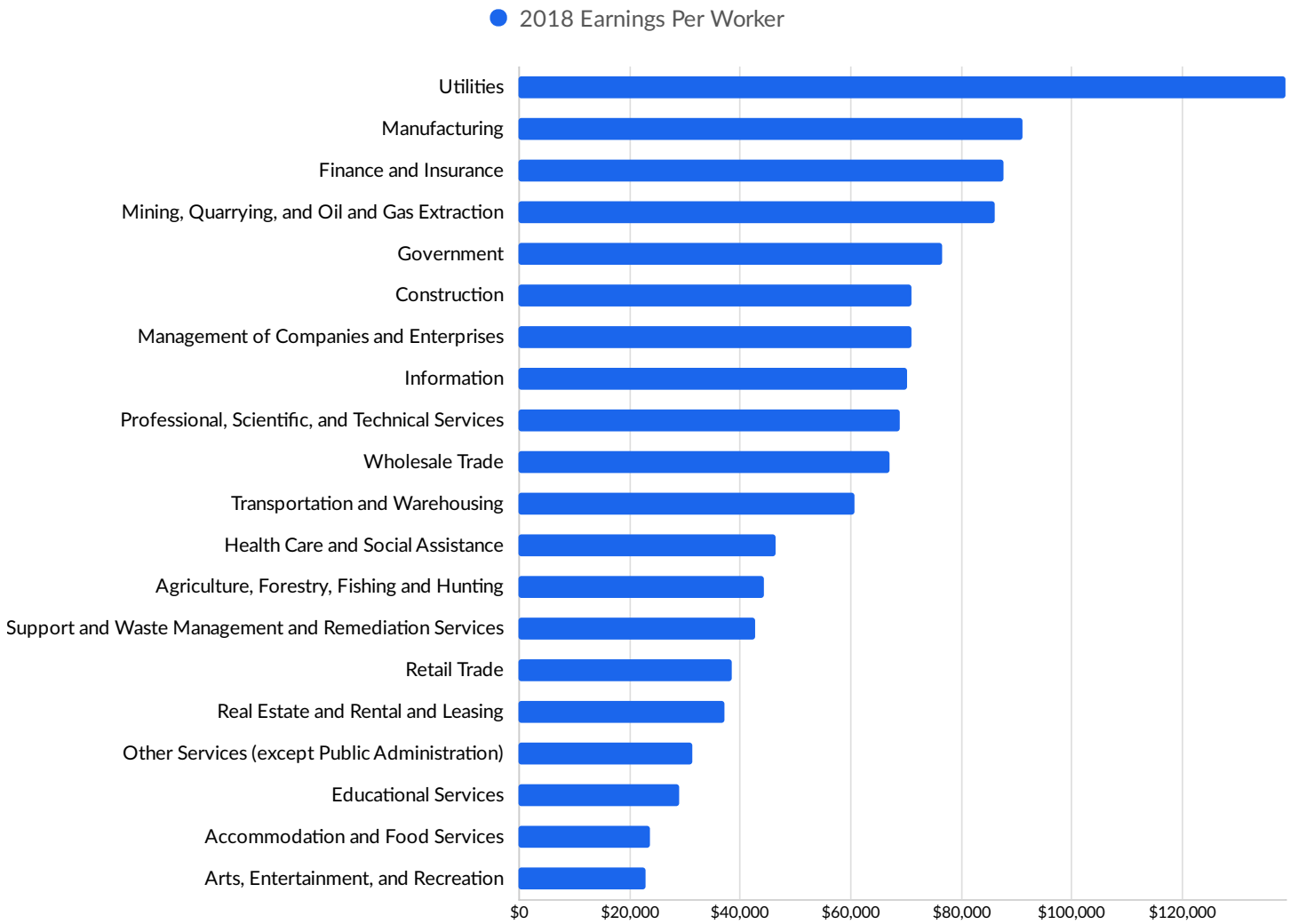

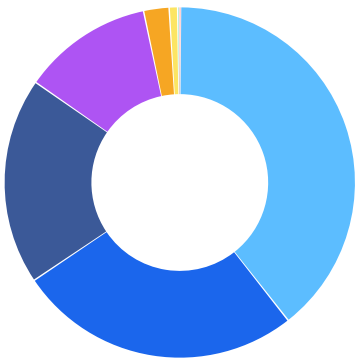

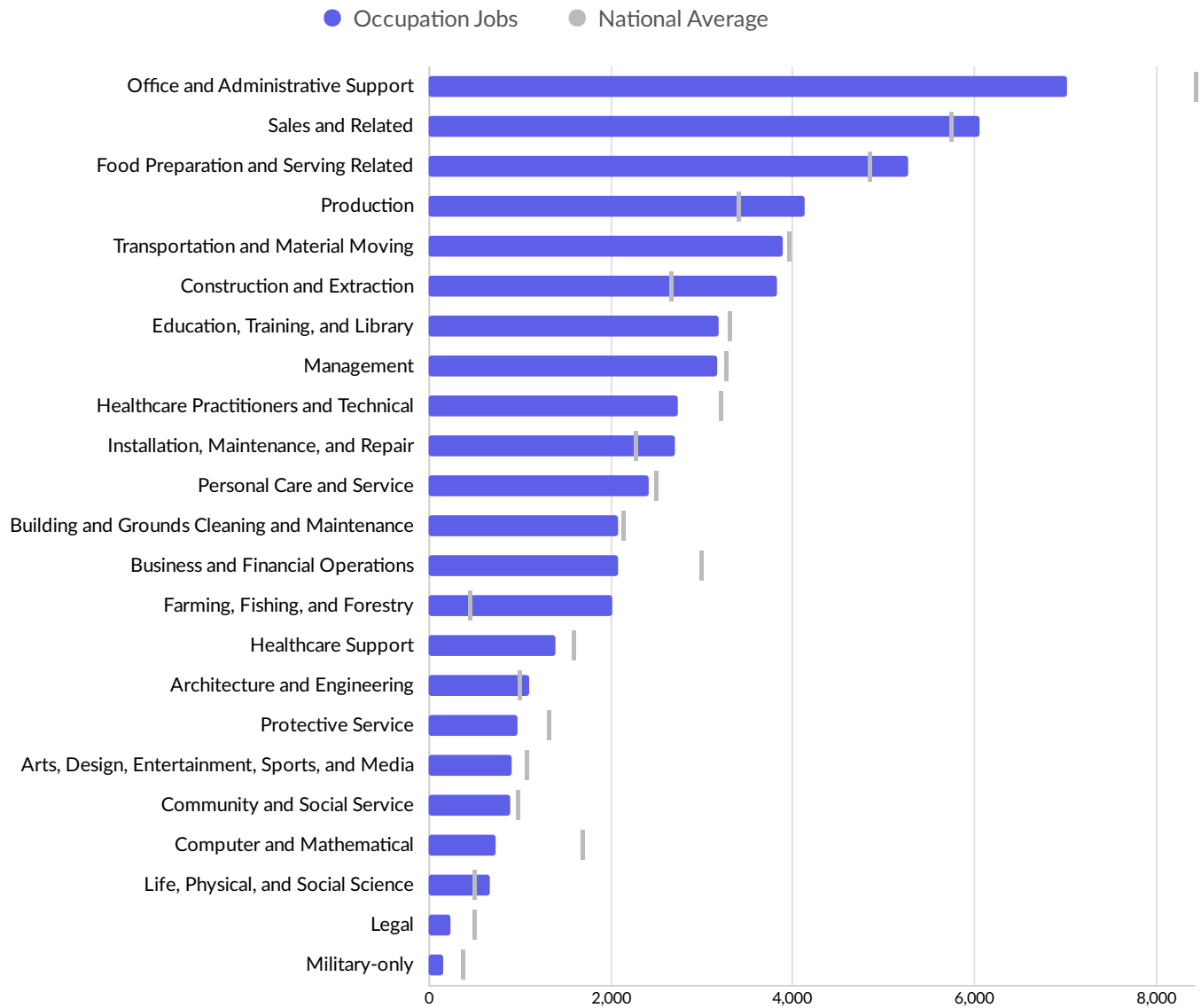

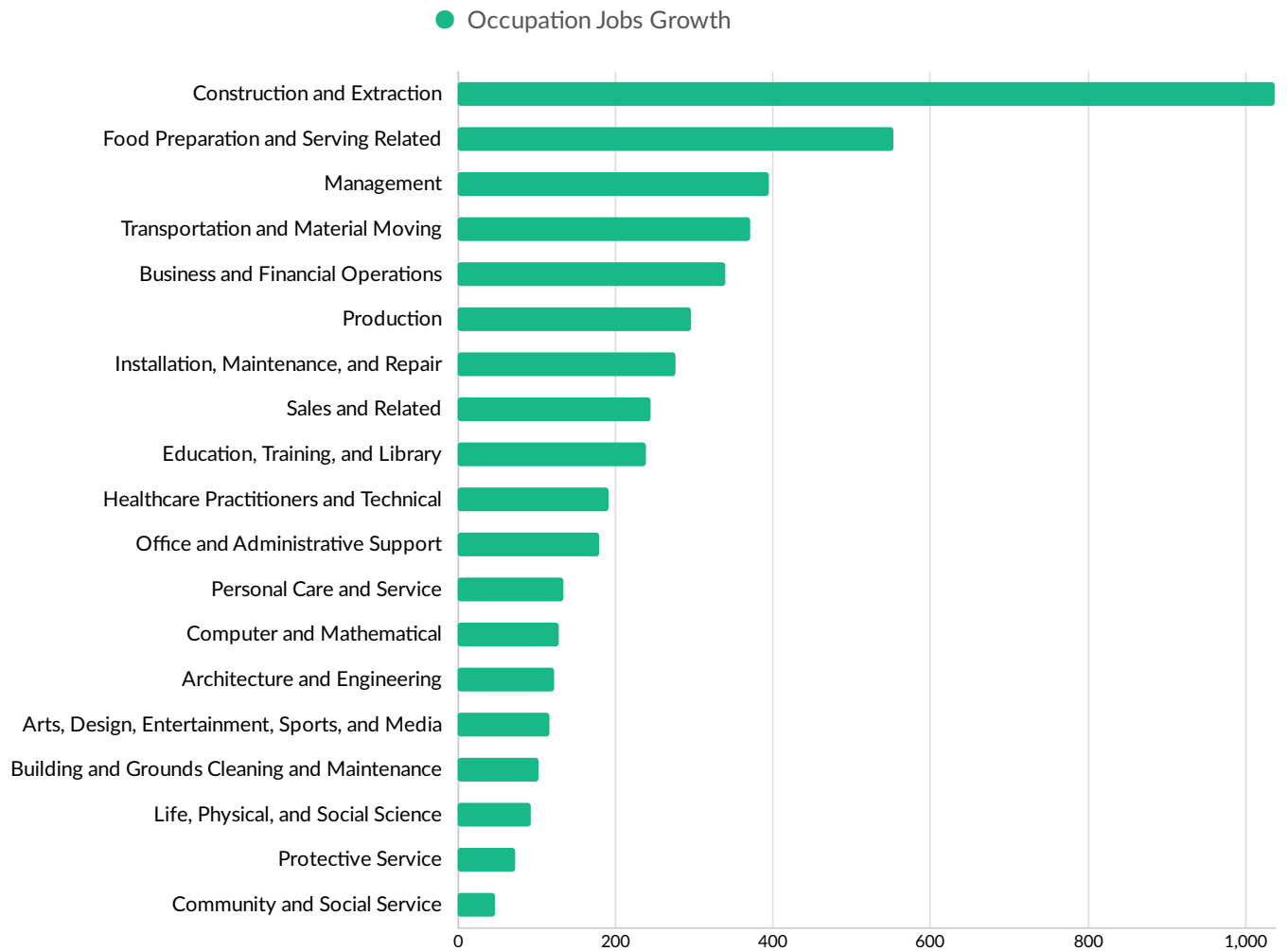

Largest Occupations



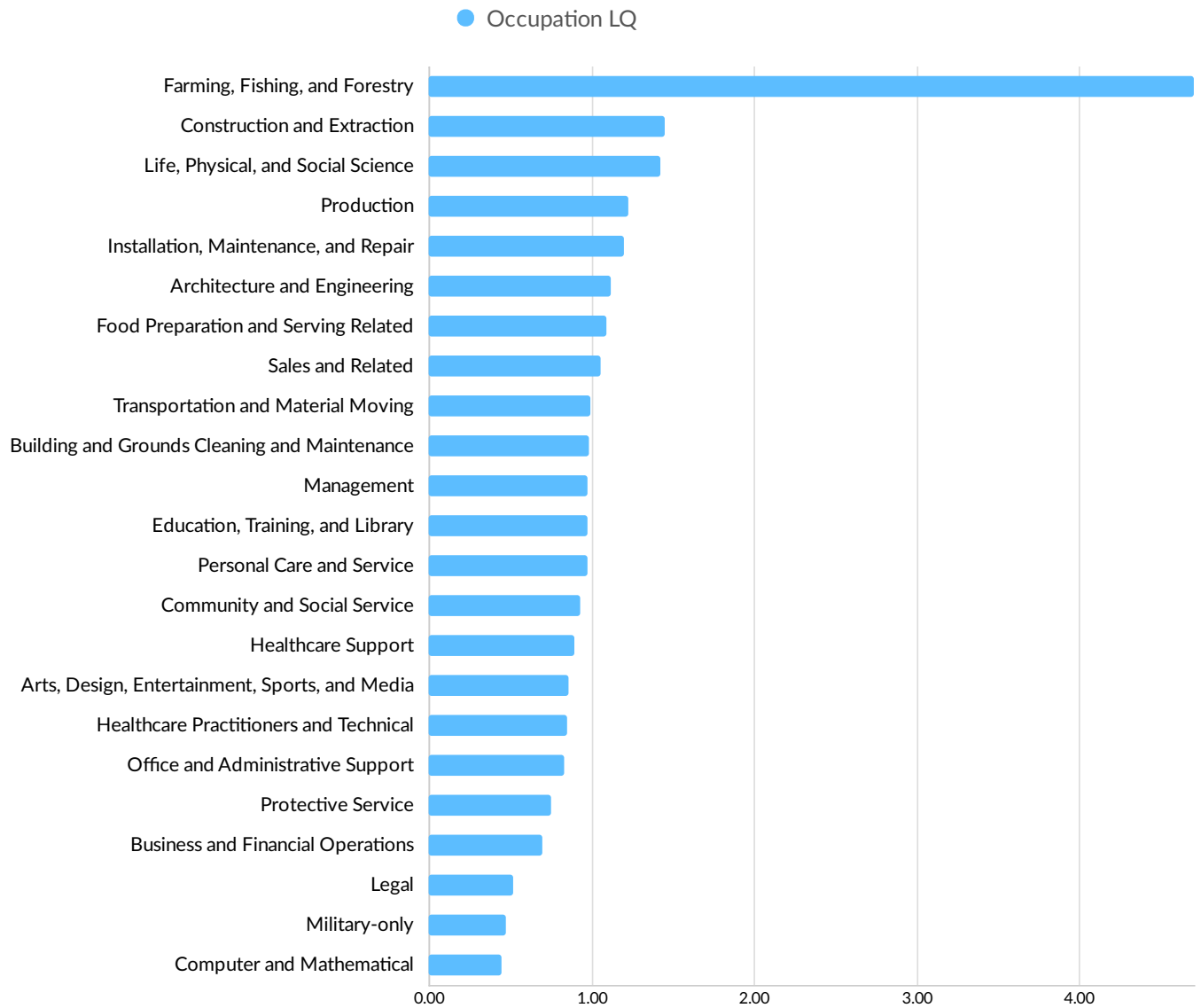

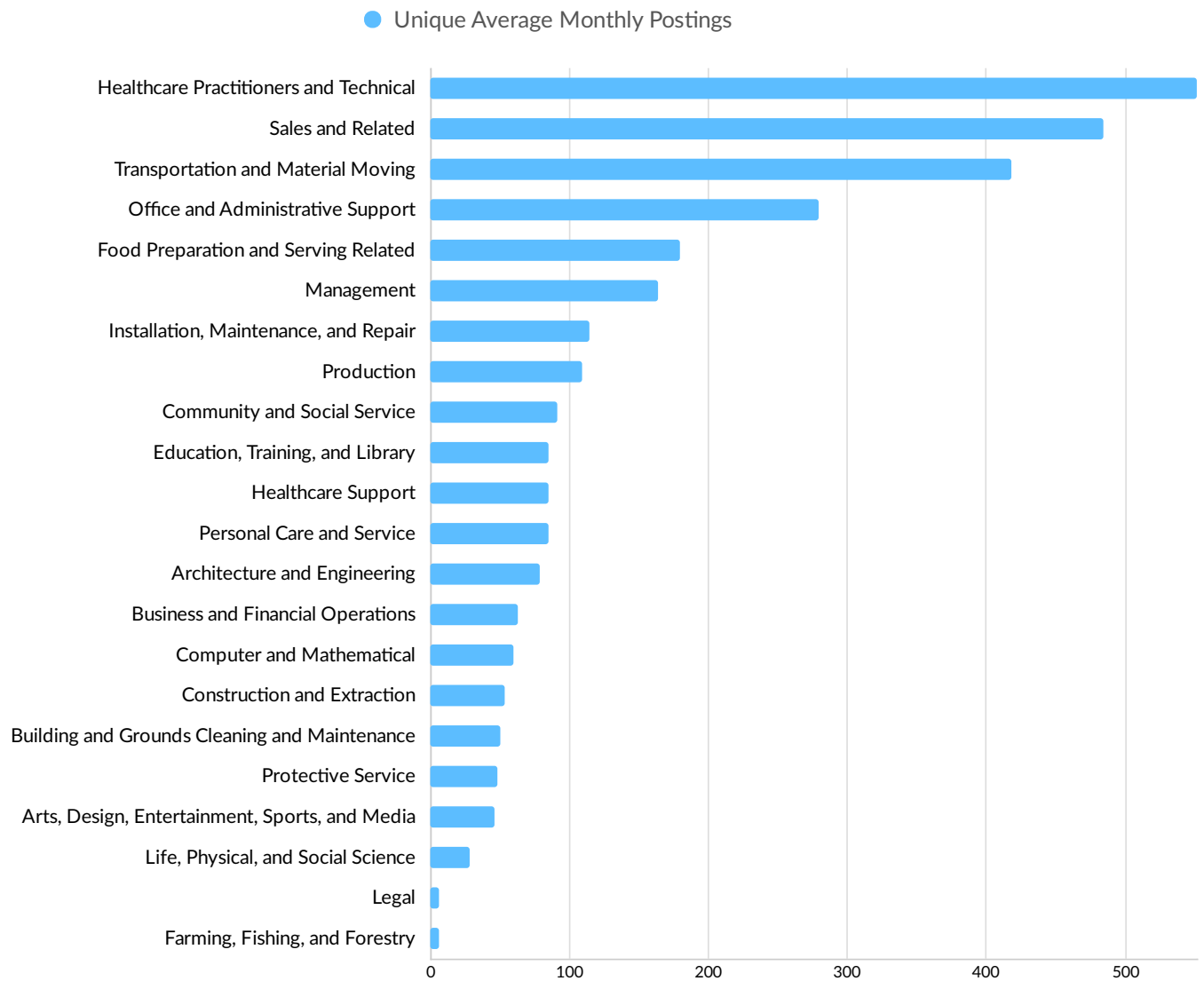

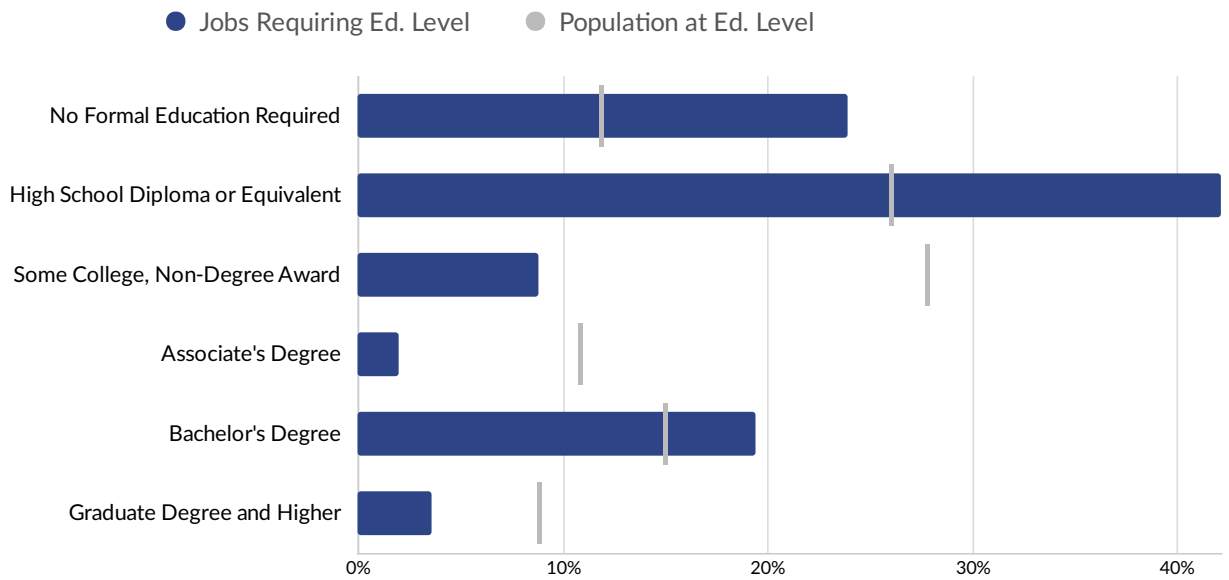

Educational Pipeline

In 2017, there were 1,373 graduates in Mount Vernon-Anacortes, WA. This pipeline has grown by 16% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies, Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide, and Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse.
